



## **Michael Joschko, Ph.D. - Biography**

Michael Joschko is a psychologist registered in the Provinces of British Columbia, Alberta, Manitoba and Ontario. He practices in the area of clinical neuropsychology and clinical psychology and for the last 30 years he has specialized in assessing the neuropsychological and psychological problems that occur during childhood, adolescence and the early adult years.

He is the Senior Psychologist and Coordinator of Neuropsychology Services at the Queen Alexandra Center for Children's Health, which is a part of the Vancouver Island Health Authority. He was a faculty member in the Department of Psychology at the University of Victoria from 1983 to 2000 — since then he has been Adjunct Associate Professor in this Department. He conducts a private practice in Victoria in the areas of clinical neuropsychology and clinical psychology.

He received his B.Sc. (Honours) in Psychology from McMaster University, and his M.A. and Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology from the University of Windsor.
