Dr. Derryck Smith graduated from Medical School at the University of Western Ontario and completed training and certification in psychiatry at the University of British Columbia in 1985. He was Head of the Division of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry at the University of British Columbia for 25 years. He is Past President of the British Columbia Medical Association.

Currently Dr. Smith focuses his practice on treating Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder and brain injury in children and adults. He also completes psychiatric assessments for individuals with workplace disabilities and performs Independent Medical Examinations for the courts.

Dr. Smith is a Clinical Professor with the Department of Psychiatry and is active in clinical teaching of medical students and residents.
