

**Research Study Name:**

A disconnect between motor milestone achievement and motor development in Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder; implications for intervention.

**What is the goal of this Study?**

Approximately 50% of children with Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) have a substantial motor difficulty. The aim of this study is to compare the motor difficulty observed in ADHD to the motor difficulty observed in Developmental Coordination Disorder (DCD)/dyspraxia. We want to better understand the early development of motor ability in these two groups by finding out whether the motor difficulties observed in many children with ADHD and all children with DCD are present from infancy. This knowledge will enable us to decide when/how to intervene, to help people with ADHD and people with DCD to achieve their potential in the motor domain. This might, in turn, help with other areas of development. For comparison, we will also be collecting the same data from typically developing children.

**Who can join this study?**

Parents/caregivers of children aged 8 to 16 years who have a diagnosis of ADHD.

**What will happen if I take part in this study?**

This is an online study. You are not required to travel to meet with us. If you agree to take part, we will then ask you to consent using our online consent form. You will also be emailed this information sheet to keep and a record of your consent. Your involvement will take up to one hour. You can also take breaks while filling in the questionnaires and return to them later. We would also like your child's teacher, where possible, to complete one five minute questionnaire. Should they agree, we will ask you to provide their email address, and we will send them an information sheet, and a link to a consent form and an online questionnaire. There is also an option for you to upload two videos. One of your child learning to walk, and one of your child walking now.
