Multi-Center, Open Label Evaluation of the Effect and Safety of Lisdexamfetamine (Vyvanse) in Children Aged 6-12 with Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder and Autism Spectrum Disorder

What is the goal of this Study?

If your child has ADHD and autism, you are aware that these conditions can be difficult to diagnose and manage. This study is researching a Health Canada-approved medication called Vyvanse, to find out how it works in children 6 to 12 years of age with ADHD and autism.

Who can join this study?

Boys and girls, 6-12 years of age with a diagnosis of both ADHD and ASD-level 1, who can attend in-person appointments in Ottawa, Ontario.

What will happen if I take part in this study?

Eligible participants will be seen by a doctor and receive all study-related exams, care and medications at no cost. Your child will be in the study for about 3 months, with 7 on-site appointments in Ottawa, Ontario. The medication will be prescribed by the study doctor, and your child will take it once a day. Your child will have regular check-ups with the doctor to determine how the medication is working, and evaluate any possible side effects. Your doctor may continue to prescribe this medication on completion of the study. Reimbursement for study-related travel and expenses is available.
