

Research Study Name:	Emotional Intelligence, Well-Being, and Social Support in Adults with ADHD
What is the goal of this Study?	The purpose of this study is to explore the association between emotional intelligence and self-reported stimulant medication usage (or non-usage) with the outcomes of subjective well-being and perceived social support in adults with ADHD. In addition, a possible moderating role of stimulant medication will be explored.
