	For the treatment of children age 6 to 25 years of age diagnosed with ADHD, who require 12 hours of continuous drug coverage due to academic and psycho-social need and who meet the following: Demonstrate significant and problematic disruptive behaviour OR have problems with inattention that interferes with learning; AND Have been tried on methylphenidate (Ritalin) immediate or sustained-release tablets with unsatisfactory results. Must be prescribed or recommended by a pediatrician, psychiatrist, or general practitioner with expertise in the treatment of ADHD. Refer to maximum billable dose as indicated.
